Investigation App

Our Incident App now includes an investigation component. It's built using the **5-Why Method**. The app works the same, those in the field use it to document incidents and then submit them.

Once submitted, the Administrator is notified and the investigation begins. The Administrator creates a "Problem Statement" and then uses our "5-Why" interface to identify causal factors.

From there, you create "Action Items" for each of the causal factors and assign action items to appropriate personnel via email. Those responding to action items do not need to have a license.

The system will track the action items and let you know when they are closed. Once all of them are closed, the system will show that the investigation is completed.

All of this is easily managed through the administrative site.
